STEM U is the official summer travel program of **STEM Study Tours**, a U.S.-based educational tour operator specializing in immersive STEM experiences for schools and youth worldwide. Our mission is to take learning beyond the classroom through exhilarating, hands-on adventures in science, technology, engineering, and math - all while exploring the globe.

At STEM U, students dive into real-world applications of STEM in dynamic international settings. Each program is designed to spark curiosity, build global awareness, and introduce participants to cutting-edge technologies and diverse career paths. Along the way, students strengthen teamwork, leadership, and practical skills - gaining confidence and forming lasting connections that support future success.

Who Can Join?

STEM U programs are open to individual students ages 14–18, with travel offered on specific dates for programs. On our Mexico Scuba Week, students travel independently and book individual flights, allowing you to book the cabin/class of your preference and being able to utilize airline miles or other travel programs if desired. Our team will meet you as soon as you clear Customs & Immigrations and take responsibility for your student at that point.

Three student STEM U Weeks are offered in 2026: **Spain** for general STEM, **Italy** for Engineering, Physics and Math, and **Cozumel** for Marine Science and Scuba Diving Certification. Each year, we also offer one FAMILY destination, open to guests of all ages traveling together. In 2026, this trip is offered to **South Africa** for Wildlife Conservation.

Safety & Supervision

STEM U students are supervised by a team of trained Chaperones, led by a professional Tour Director. A licensed nurse or medical official travels with each group to ensure health and safety throughout the journey.

Students stay in shared accommodations by gender, with each participant assigned their own bed. If traveling with friends, please ask us for roommate friendship groups if you would like. All travelers must agree to and follow our Code of Conduct, which is reviewed and signed during registration.

What's Included?

STEM U programs are designed for ease and peace of mind. In Mexico, all ground expenses - including lodging, meals, activities, and supervision - are covered. Families only need to budget for flights, travel insurance, souvenirs and optional snacks / beverages when off property. STEM U Family Weeks have varied inclusions so you can enjoy family time alongside your tour time.

Cozumel.... Cozumel, Mexico is a vibrant island in the Caribbean Sea, renowned for its crystal-clear waters, thriving coral reefs, and rich cultural heritage.

As one of the world's top scuba diving destinations, Cozumel offers students a rare opportunity to explore marine ecosystems firsthand while immersing themselves in the rhythms of island life. From the ancient ruins of Tulum to the bustling markets of San Miguel, the region blends ecological wonder with historical depth, making it an ideal setting for experiential learning. The STEM U itinerary maximizes this potential, combining rigorous scuba certification training with marine science education, cultural excursions, and service projects that foster global awareness and environmental stewardship.

Participating in this program equips students with both technical skills and a deeper understanding of ocean conservation. Through confined and open water dives, students earn their scuba certification - a credential that opens doors to a wide range of careers. Certified divers can pursue paths in marine biology, underwater archaeology, environmental science, oceanography, and even commercial diving or underwater photography. For those interested in STEM fields, this experience lays the groundwork for future research, fieldwork, and advocacy roles that require comfort and competence in aquatic environments. The inclusion of service projects and educational programs like the Stingray Beach initiative further reinforces the importance of responsible tourism and marine protection.

Beyond the academic and career benefits, this trip cultivates resilience, teamwork, and curiosity. Students learn to navigate new environments, collaborate under pressure, and reflect on their role in preserving fragile ecosystems. Whether they're rappelling into cenotes or analyzing reef health, they're not just observing the world - they're engaging with it. This kind of immersive, interdisciplinary travel experience can be transformative, sparking lifelong passions and shaping future leaders in science, sustainability, and global citizenship.

Dive Registration – We'll start at the Dive Shop today to complete all our paperwork and get set up with our instructors. Pro Dive's watersports Centers have all been awarded the prestigious National Geographic Green Star Award. The Pro Dive team are our trusted partners and their Instructors will make sure every single person is set up for the very best marine experience.



Certified Divers: Scuba Refresher – Taking a scuba refresher is a smart way to rebuild confidence and ensure safety before returning to the water. It covers essential skills like buoyancy control, equipment setup, and emergency procedures, helping certified divers stay sharp and prepared. Whether it's been months or years since your last dive, a refresher sets the stage for a smoother, more enjoyable underwater experience.



New Divers: Theory Review with Instructors, Confined Water Training with Equipment – Students get to learn the skills they've trained for! From equipment set-up and use to the first round of skills and requirements in the water, they'll work with their dedicated instructors to master the tasks they'll need in the ocean.

Afternoon Activity:



All Divers: Ocean Dives 1 & 2 – Dive into the blue with your instructors to experience true marine science. What makes diving in Cozumel amazing is the clarity of the Caribbean Sea, with up to 200 feet visibility. Many famous oceanographers have praised these reefs for their beauty and abundant marine life. The Cozumel National Marine Park is a paradise for scuba diving. It's the protected home to one of the most incredible coral reefs and marine inhabitants on the planet.

Afternoon activity:



All Divers: Ocean Dives 3 & 4 – The Cozumel Marine Park covers about 29,600 acres of safeguarded ocean and coastline estimated to be the home of 262 species of fish swimming between 105 different types of coral. These reefs are literally teeming with sea life. Drift diving is very common in Cozumel; allowing you to float effortlessly from one turtle to the next and glide along deep walls. The coral reefs here are punctured by swim-throughs and tunnels which lead onto the giant sponges and coral banks of Colombia Reef.

Day 4

Breakfast, lunch & dinner included

Today's activities include:



Ferry to the Mainland – Take a ride on the wild side as we cross the channel by boat to Playa del Carmen on the mainland. It's a 45-minute ride but we'll sit in comfort in interior or exterior cabins as we make the passage. Grab a good book, close your eyes and listen to your music, or watch the waves roll past as we embark on a fun journey to explore the mainland!



Tulum Archaeological Park - The Tulum Archaeological Park is a stunning Mayan site perched on cliffs overlooking the Caribbean Sea. Once a thriving walled city and trade hub, it offers insight into ancient culture and history. Students visiting experience both breathtaking scenery and a deeper connection to the Maya civilization.



Adventure Sports: Ziplining, Rappelling, Cenotes – This adventure offers a thrilling mix of activities deep in the Riviera Maya jungle. Begin with an exhilarating zipline ride through the treetops. Next, descend into a cenote by rappelling, a truly unique experience that brings you into the refreshing, crystal-clear waters of a sacred natural pool. Finally, enjoy swimming and relaxing in the cenote, discovering the unique underwater rock formations that make these pools famous.



Playa del Carmen Shopping & Exploration – Before heading back to our island, enjoy a bit of time to explore Playa del Carmen. Playa del Carmen is a lively beach town in Mexico's Riviera Maya, known for its walkable streets and white-sand beaches. Students can explore boutique shops, gourmet restaurants, and picture-perfect backdrops to set up that perfect selfie. For students, it offers a balance of cultural immersion and recreation, making it a dynamic stop during their Mexican adventure.

Day 5

Breakfast, lunch & dinner included

Today's activities include:



All Divers: Morning Dive - Cozumel is famous for its drift diving. Currents are usually mild (1 – 2 knots) allowing divers to glide effortlessly along the reefs. The Gulf Stream runs along the entire coast of Quintana Roo, flowing from the south to the north, with its intensity dependent upon weather conditions, seasons and the moon. Today, divers will enjoy this underwater paradise as they drift effortlessly along in search of amazing aquatic life!



San Miguel Town Excursion - In the lively town of San Miguel, students can stroll along the colorful waterfront and explore bustling local markets filled with handmade crafts and souvenirs. They can sample authentic Mexican flavors and enjoy refreshing treats like tropical fruit or homemade ice cream (extra costs apply). This is a chance to experience Cozumel's vibrant culture firsthand, from street art and music to the warm hospitality of the island's residents.



Waves of Grace Service Project - At Waves of Grace Community Church, students connect with Cozumel's youth through a meaningful service project and shared fellowship. The evening includes bringing donations for local children, enjoying a pizza dinner together, and joining in lively games like volleyball, kickball, and soccer. This experience offers a heartfelt opportunity to build friendships, give back to the community, and celebrate the joy of cultural exchange.

Today's activities include:



Pre-Certified Divers: Morning Dive – These are the last dives of the trip and only included for students who were pre-certified and have registered for 4-days of 2-tank dives. If you are a newly certified diver, or a student earning their advance dive certification, you can certainly sign up, it will just be at extra cost. This is a chance to catch glimpses of those last sharks and rays, follow that last turtle, and take a last glance at the amazing corals and sponges. Cozumel's underwater world is truly spectacular!



Stingray Beach Education Program - Get ready to splash around at Stingray Beach, where you'll meet friendly stingrays up close! You can feed them, hold them, and learn cool facts about their underwater world. It's the perfect mix of ocean adventure and unforgettable fun with your friends! Plus, you'll walk away with amazing stories to share and memories that will last long after the trip.



Certificate Presentation & Farewell Reflection - At the end of the week, each student is recognized to celebrate their achievements. Whether they've completed their Open Water Diver or Advanced Open Water Diver course – or simply joined the dives for fun - we ensure everyone has a title to honor their experience. This tradition not only acknowledges hard work and growth but is also a chance for the entire team to come together and truly process their experiences. Through guided discussions and thought-provoking questions, we'll unpack the amazing things they've seen, heard, and felt throughout the trip.

Day 7

Today it is time to say goodbye to Mexico as we pack up and head for home. Registration & Booking Notes

Documentation & Passport Requirements

- ❖ All participants must register using their full legal name exactly as shown on their passport (including middle names). Please double-check all details - name, date of birth, gender, passport number, and issue/expiration dates - to ensure accuracy.
- ❖ If your passenger does not have a valid passport at the time of registration, we ask for this to be applied for immediately after registration. At times, passports may take an extended amount of time to process so please apply as soon as registration is complete. All passport information must be received by us, through the registration portal, a minimum of 60-days prior to travel.
- ❖ Upon arrival in Mexico, we will collect all passports and hold these for safe keeping, re-issuing them for return flights home. Please know and understand the process if your student were to lose their passport as it can be trying at best. More information on this process may be found in our online Documents Library.

Payments

- ❖ An initial deposit is required at registration to confirm your trip.
- ❖ Deposits are paid through the portal by linking your bank account, no fee for payment services. 11 currencies are accepted: USD, GBP, EUR, CAD, AUD, NZD, CHF, DKK, NOK, SEK, PLN, HKD, MXN.
- ❖ Wire transfers and credit card payments are also accepted, however the banking center does charge a 4% fee for use.
- ❖ Remaining balances are divided into equal monthly payments, with all payments completed 60 days before departure.

Agreements & Parent/Guardian Forms

- ❖ During registration, families must review and agree to: [Booking Conditions](#), [Assumption of Risk & Liability Release](#) and our [Code of Conduct](#). A Photography Release is optional but appreciated.
- ❖ Each parent/legal guardian must submit [Permission to Travel Abroad](#), [Medical Release](#) (required to seek treatment if needed) and [Consent for Medicine Administration](#).
- ❖ Each student room will be routinely checked. Please be prepared to pay for any damages which your child may incur. These will be reviewed with you, but do understand, if your child has created damage, you are solely responsible for any bills associated with repair.

Travel Insurance

- ❖ Each person traveling must have a valid travel insurance policy that covers both travel and medical, valid for your specific travel dates. If you are a resident of the USA, you may feel free to obtain this through our partner, Travel Insured, a widely recognized insurance provider that serves our groups. Registration Link: [TRAVEL INSURED](#) Please ensure you are booked through this specific link as it is tied to our company and we will receive your travel insurance documents to keep on file.
- ❖ If you are departing from abroad and need an insurance referral, please let us know. This may generally be purchased at the time you purchase independent flights.
- ❖ If you are purchasing elsewhere, you will be asked to email in a copy of your travel insurance so we have it on file and can access it if needed. Please email this to info@stemstudytours.com and include the trip destination, the name of the passenger and the outbound travel date.
- ❖ Please remember that no insurance = no travel, so please insure this is in place as it is mandatory, a minimum of 60 days prior to travel.

- ❖ Prior to travel we will have a group video chat for your student to meet us and answer any questions your family may have. If you have specific questions you would like answered before registering, please feel free to contact our offices during business hours (USA Central time zone).
- ❖ During travel, we will have two WhatsApp groups: one only for students for general tour communications, and one only for parents as a daily update on what the group is doing and how everything is progressing.
