ITALY: Civetta Resort

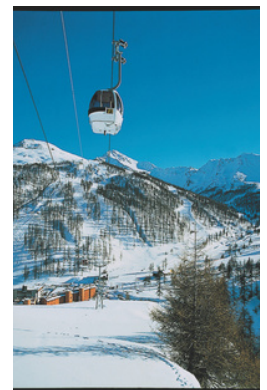
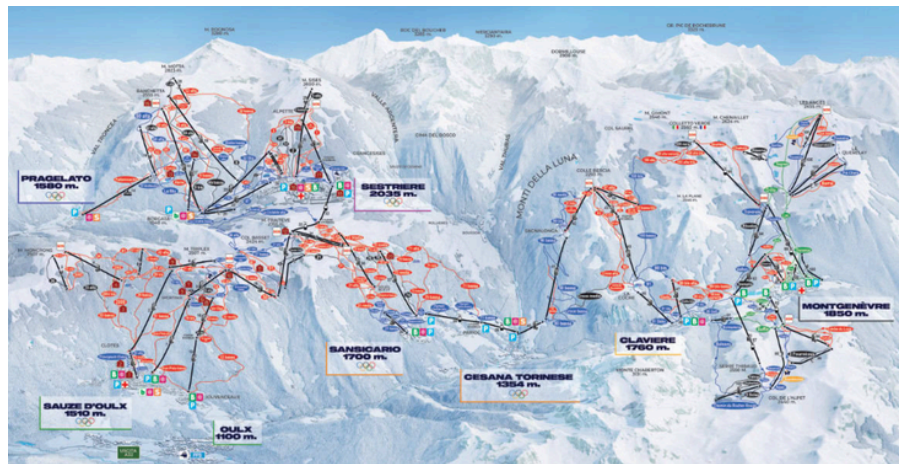

ITALY: Sestriere Resort

Sestriere Resort delivers a classic Italian Alps adventure, blending five days of winter sports instruction with the charm and culture of the Vialattea - better known as the Milky Way, one of Europe's largest interconnected ski areas. 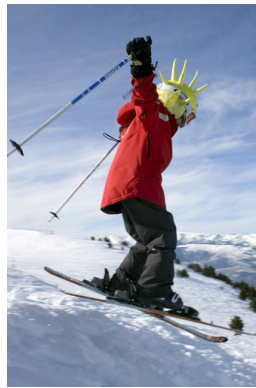

SPAIN: Alp 2500 - Masella & La Molina

AUSTRIA: Axamer Lizum

Axamer Lizum delivers a distinctly Austrian alpine experience, blending wide Olympic-heritage slopes with the charm of Tyrol's mountain culture.
